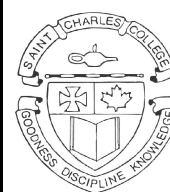

Khali Jodouin and Mr. Kolidinski for all her time and effort in designing and making all the open house t-shirts.

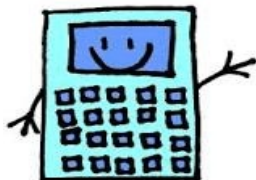
Justin Gibeault for his hard work that he produces in class.
